Baroque Authority – Baroque Glory



15,000 magnificent square metres.

The Salzburg Cathedral and Residenz Palace were the symbol for the prince archbishops' power and today create the city of Salzburg's historical centre – a totally unique Baroque work of art, the only one of its kind in Europe. For 200 years, the passages between the prince archbishop's palace, the Cathedral and the cabinet of art and painting galleries were closed. With the creation of the DomQuartier, the original unit of the cathedral-palace complex – including the St. Peter Benedictine abbey – is restored. On a spectacular tour, 134 doors open 2,000 exhibits from 1,300 years of art and cultural history to the public.

The Tour de Baroque leads visitors to the "bel étage" (principal floor) of this one-of-a-kind ensemble around the Domplatz (Cathedral Square) and provides astounding views of the city, as well as undreamt-of views of the architectural sights and Baroque treasures: views of the Residenz Palace state rooms and the Residence Gallery, the Cathedral's terrific chancel and oratories, the Cathedral Museum and the cabinet of art, the painting gallery and the newly founded Museum of St. Peter.

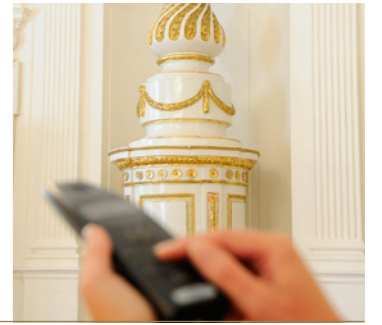

1: On Your Own Through the DomQuartier

Visitors who prefer an individual tour through the DomQuartier can take advantage of our free audio guide available in eight languages (German, English, Italian, French, Spanish, Russian, Mandarin and Japanese). Information and anecdotes about the moving past of the prince archbishops, as well as exciting details about the architecture, escort you through the DomQuartier. 2: Classic DomQuartier Tour: Baroque Authority – Baroque Glory

Under expert guidance, you will walk in the footsteps of the powerful prince archbishops. You can expect to see magnificently decorated state rooms, the Residence Gallery's fantastic paintings, incredible views into the Cathedral and the church's treasures in the Cathedral Museum. Stride through the cabinet of art and curiosities and the Long Gallery of St. Peter's Abbey. In the new Museum of St. Peter, you will see precious objects from the Benedictine monastery's art collection.

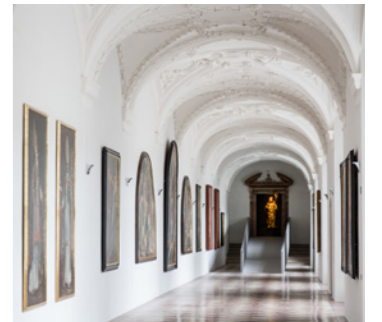

3: Tour with a Focus on St. Peter

The extremely rich art collection of the St. Peter Benedictine Abbey is comprised of an estimated 40,000 pieces. A selection of special treats from the abbey's artistic treasures is being presented for the first time in its own museum. The museum is divided into three categories: St. Peter and art, St. Peter and music, and St. Peter in history and constitution. On this special tour, you will be amazed by the unique artistic treasures from the oldest monastery in the German-speaking world.

4: Express Tour

Over the course of one hour, you will wander through the former prince archbishops' centre of power with its incredible history and unique artistic treasures and get a closer look at the prince archbishops' work. You will experience the state rooms of the Residenz Palace and get views into the Cathedral, as well as a look at the collections in the Residence Gallery, Cathedral Museum, Museum of St. Peter and the Salzburg Museum's Baroque Rossacher Collection. This highly interesting architectural tour is completed by magnificent views of the city of Salzburg.
