The DomQuartier tour

The DomQuartier affords a unique survey of 1,300 years of political domination, art, music and architecture. It is the authentic place in the centre of the Salzburg UNESCO World Heritage site to experience history through all the senses.

You'll encounter magnificently furnished staterooms, fantastic paintings in the Residenz Gallery, a unique view from the Dombogenterrasse, exciting special exhibitions in the north oratory of the cathedral, the

fabulous view inside the cathedral from the west gallery, and the ecclesiastical treasures of the Cathedral Museum. You pass through the Cabinet of Art and Curiosities and the Long Gallery of St. Peter, which has an amazing architectural history. In the Museum of St. Peter, the most beautiful objects from the rich art collections of the Benedictine monastery are on display. After walking through the Kaiser Hall, you arrive back where the tour started: the magnificent Carabinieri Hall.

Reformer in a new light

250 years ago, Count Hieronymus Colloredo was elected Archbishop of Salzburg. The first exhibition on Colloredo, the last ecclesiastical ruler, will deal with many different aspects of his 31-year reign, rectifying various clichés.
